

## SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL

*Suffolk County Council (Parish of Halesworth) (Rectory Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 198*

Notice is hereby given that Suffolk County Council propose to make the above Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at all times in Rectory Street, Halesworth, from a point 72 metres north-west of its junction with Bridge Street in a north-westerly direction for 25 metres.

Exceptions in the Order allow a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight; goods to be loaded or unloaded; for the purposes of building or demolition; and for certain other purposes as specified in the draft Order. There are also the usual exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles.

A copy of the draft Order and a map showing the road affected, together with the Council's reasons for preparing to make the Order, may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Waveney District Council, London Road, Halesworth, and at my office.

Objections to the Order, specifying the grounds on which they are made, must be in writing and must reach me not later than 11th April 1984.

## SCHEDULE 1

*Sides of road at Margate in the County of Kent**Queen Street*

North-west side, from High Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 70 feet.

South-east side, from a point 69 feet north-east of High Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 61 feet.

## SCHEDULE 2

*Queen Street*

North-west side, from a point 112 feet north-east of High Street, in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 90 feet.

South-east side, from a point 130 feet north-east of High Street, in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 85 feet.

## THANET DISTRICT COUNCIL

*The Thanet District Council (Queen Street, Margate, Kent) (Regulation) Order 1984*

Notice is hereby given that the Thanet District Council, in exercise of powers delegated to it by the Kent County Council, has made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and other enabling powers on 12th March 1984. The Order will come into operation on 20th March 1984.

When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, to cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day on any of the sides of Queen Street, Margate, from its junction with High Street, to its junction with Cecil Square.

The Order contains exceptions to permit:

- (1) Waiting for so long as may be necessary for persons to board or alight, in connection with building operations, removal of obstruction, maintenance, statutory undertakers, fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes and for delivering or collecting postal packets.
- (2) Waiting for so long as may be necessary, for loading or unloading of goods (a) at any time on any day on the sides of Queen Street specified in Schedule 1 to this notice and (b) at any time, except between the hours of 8 a.m. and midnight, on the sides of Queen Street specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.
- (3) The waiting of disabled persons' vehicles, displaying a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (correctly marked), restricted to 2 hours with return within 1 hour prohibited.

Notice is hereby given that the Thanet District Council, in exercise of powers delegated to it by the Kent County Council, has made the above Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and other enabling powers on 12th March 1984. The Orders will come into operation on 20th March 1984.

The effects of the Orders are:

- (a) To revise the existing parking places to allow parking 1 hour in any 2 on Monday to Saturday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. within the positions specified in Schedule I to this notice.
- (b) To prohibit waiting except for hackney carriages in the lengths of road specified in Schedule II to this notice.
- (c) To prohibit waiting except for stage carriages in the lengths of road specified in Schedule III to this notice.
- (d) To prohibit driving in the lengths of road specified in Schedule IV to this notice.

The Orders contain exceptions to permit waiting for statutory undertakers, police, fire and ambulance vehicles, goods to be loaded or unloaded and disabled persons' vehicles.
