SCHEDULE I

Prohibition of driving

Cecil Square, within areas defined as follows:

(1) Central paved area

- East side (Hawley Street. The continuation of the western kerb-line of Hawley Street from the north-ern kerb-line of Cecil Square in a south-westerly direction to a point 70 feet west of the eastern kerb-line of Hawley Street and 65 feet south of the northern kerb-line of Cecil Square.
- South side, from a point 70 feet west of the eastern kerb-line of Hawley Street and 65 feet south of the northern kerb-line of Cecil Square in an easterly direction to a point 53 feet east of the western kerb-line and 65 feet north of the southern kerb-line of Cecil Square, excluding a bus bay, overall length 165 feet, maximum width 10 feet.
- North side, from a point 56 feet east of the western kerb-line and 36 feet south of the northern kerb-line of Cecil Square, in a westerly direction to a point 238 feet east of the western kerb-line and 42 feet south of the northern kerb-line of Cecil Square.
