NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971, SECTION 210

The Epsom and Ewell Borough Council (Prospect Place) (Footpath No. 102) Stopping-up Order 1984

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on 21st March 1984 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Epsom and Ewell Borough Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to extinguish public footpath No. 102 running from Hawthorne Place to Clayton Road, Epsom, and to create an alternative footpath, in lieu, to a line running from the junction at Hawthorne Place to the southern extremity of Clayton Road.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it is deposited at the Town Hall, The Parade, Epsom, Surrey, and may be inspected there free of charge between the hours of 8.50 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday from 22nd March 1984 to 19th April 1984. Copies of the map and Order may be purchased.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Epsom and Ewell Borough Council at the Town Hall, The Parade, Epsom, Surrey, not later than 19th April 1984 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made or if any so made are withdrawn the Epsom and Ewell Borough Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for Confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted

to the Secretary of State for confirmation, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to the Secretary of State with the Order.

Development Plan for the County of Greater Manchester (Continuation in Force) (No. 1) Order 1984

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to his powers in that regard the Secretary of State for the Environment has made the above-mentioned Order which is operative from 23rd January 1984.

The Order provides for all the provisions of the old development plan, comprising the documents specified in Schedule 1 to the Order (development plans in force in the County of Greater Manchester) to continue in force in relation to the area to which the Greater Manchester Green Belt Local Plan relates as shown hatched on the map annexed to the Order, following the adoption by the Greater Manchester Council of the local plan.

The Order does not apply to the area in which the following revocation order was made under Schedule 7, paragraph 6 of the 1971 Act:

The Town and Country Planning (Repeal of Provisions No. 46) Salford (Brunswick) Order 1980.

The Order does not apply to the areas of local plans adopted since 13th November 1980 and in respect of which the old development plan was revoked under Schedule 7, paragraph 5A, of the 1971 Act.
