

which is to prohibit any heavy commercial vehicles (as defined in section 104 of the Act) from proceeding in either Park Lane or Park Avenue.

The Order will not apply to any heavy commercial vehicle which has an unladen weight not exceeding 3.05 tonnes. There is an exception to the Order relating to access to property for specific purposes.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 1st May 1984 together with a map showing the roads concerned may be examined during normal office hours Monday to Friday at Room 308, Civic Centre, Barnstaple.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 20th March 1984 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Newnham Road, Plympton, Plympton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1983
