which will be to impose a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. on the
following length of road in Danes Green in the Parish of
North Claines in the District of Wychavon in the county
of Hereford and Worcester:

Danes Green Road, from its junction with Jacobs Ladder Lane for a distance of 91 metres (300 feet) in an easterly direction (i.e. to extend the existing 30 m.p.h. speed limit to its junction with Jacobs Ladder Lane). The Order will come into operation on 3rd April 1984.

A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act of 1967 or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made (such date stated in this notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.

North Hertfordshire District Council (Various Roads, Royston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1984.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

## Roads in Royston

# Kneesworth Street

(1) On the east side:

(a) from a point 28 metres south-east of a point in line with the southern kerb-line of Mill Road south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 13 metres to a point 28 metres north-west of a point in line with the southern boundary wall of the property known as 47 Kneesworth Street;

- (b) from a point in line with the southern flank wall of No. 25 Kneesworth Street north-westwards for a distance of approximately 85 metres to a point 5 metres south-east of a point in line with the northern flank wall of No. 43 Kneesworth Street.
- (2) On the west side:
