*The Hartlepool Borough Council (Wiltshire Way)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1984*

Notice is hereby given that on 18th July 1984 Hartlepool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Cleveland in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, made the above-named Order (which has been amended from that proposed in the advertisement of 14th May 1984) the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time in that length on the east side only of Wiltshire Way, Hartlepool, from its junction with Throston Grange Lane in a southerly direction for a distance measured along the said road of 180 metres approximately.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity and water and for disabled persons.

HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Hereford and Worcester (New Road and Bromsgrove Eastern Bypass, Bromsgrove) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order 1984.

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prevent any vehicle from proceeding in a northerly direction in Bromsgrove Eastern By-pass in the Town and District of Bromsgrove in the County of Hereford and Worcester and from making a right-hand turn into New Road.

GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The Greater Manchester County (Silk Street, Church Street and Henrietta Street, Leigh) (Restriction of Waiting) (County) Order 1984.

Notice is hereby given that on 16th July 1984 the Greater Manchester County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is:

- (a) To prohibit waiting, loading and unloading between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Friday on:

Silk Street, east side, from Henrietta Street to Church Street.

- (b) To prohibit waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Friday on:

Silk Street, west side, from Henrietta Street to Church Street;

Church Street, north side, from 10 metres west of Silk Street to 10 metres east of Silk Street;

Henrietta Street, both sides, from 10 metres west of Silk Street to 10 metres east of Silk Street.

The Order which comes into operation on 13th August 1984 contains exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading and unloading (when not prohibited), funerals, building operations or work on or under the lengths of road. Disabled persons' vehicles bearing a disabled person's badge and a parking disc are able to wait for periods of 2 hours, return prohibited within 1 hour, when the loading ban is not in operation.
