WATER SHORTAGE

Notice of Application for an Emergency Order Relating to Abstraction from an Unnamed Tributary of the River Caen.

Whereas in view of an exceptional shortage of rain, a serious deficiency of supplies of water is threatened in the area of the South West Water Authority which is served from Boode-Braunton Reservoir in the Parish of Braunton in the District of North Devon in the County of Devon.

Notice is hereby given that in order to maintain an adequate supply of water the Authority is applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order pursuant to section 1 (3) (a) and (3), (4) of the Drought Act 1976, to enable it for a period not exceeding 6 months to abstract from an unnamed tributary of the River Caen by means of collecting tanks at NGR SS 513 376 and SS 506 375 a quantity not exceeding 0.45 thousand cubic metres (100,000 gallons) at a rate not exceeding 0.113 thousand cubic metres (25,000 gallons) per day in order to

replenish the Boode Reservoir at NGR SS 505 376 and thereafter to maintain the reservoir at the relevant level by subsequent abstractions not exceeding 0.113 thousand cubic metres (25,000 gallons) per day.

A copy of the statement and a plan illustrating the Authority's proposals may be inspected by any person, free of charge, during all reasonable office hours of the undersigned and at the Authority's offices at Grenville House, Boutport Street, Barnstaple for a period of 7 days from the date of the publication of this notice.

Objections to the application may be made to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Room B4.64, Romney House, 43 Marsham Street, London SW1 3PY (with a copy to the undersigned please) within 7 days of the publication of this notice.

Where it appears to the Secretary of State that the Order is required to be made urgently if it is to enable the Water Authority effectively to meet the deficiency of supplies of water referred to above, he may direct that the holding of a Public Local Inquiry or a hearing by a person appointed by him shall be dispensed with.
