

6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to:

(a) designate parking places in Danby Street, De Laune Street, Dowlas Street, Gomm Road, Nunhead Grove, Ruskin Walk, Spurling Road and Tappesfield Road, in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period during the permitted hours without charge;

(b) provide that the parking places will operate between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted);

(c) specify, in respect of the parking places, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge (commonly referred to as "the Orange Badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975 or 1982 may be left therein; and

(d) provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.

3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation for the purposes of the placing of traffic signs on 29th August 1984 and for all other purposes on 7th September 1984 and of the maps which indicate each length of road to which the Order relates can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made during normal office hours on Mondays to Friday inclusive in Room B.72, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, or on the ground that any requirement thereof or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any Regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
