

(d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, in the lengths of streets and carriageway referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above, will be prohibited;

(e) the hours during which the existing prohibition applies:

(i) on waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be changed so that it will apply between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3 to this notice and in the first 18.29 metres of adjacent Church Avenue;

(ii) on waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of 20 minutes in the same place will be changed so that it will apply between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (unless otherwise prohibited) in the lengths of streets referred to in sub-paragraph (e) (i) above and in the lengths of King Street, Southall, specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;

(f) any existing prohibitions on waiting by vehicles, on the sale of goods and on advertising activities in Adelaide Road, Church Avenue, Featherstone Road, between a point 18.29 metres north-east of the northern kerb-line of Western Road and a point 50.29 metres north-east of that kerb-line, Pluckington Place, Regina Road and Western Road, Southall (except for the existing prohibition on waiting by vehicles for the purposes of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading at the junction with King Street, Southall) imposed by the above-mentioned Order of 1977, will be revoked.

3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 (a) and (b) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc. from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "orange badge" will apply.

4. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 1st October 1984, and of the Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977 (and of the Orders which have previously amended that Order) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made in Room B.72, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

5. Copies of the Order may be obtained from the Council's Transportation and Development Department, Room 301, South Block, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

6. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

#### SCHEDULE 1

*Adelaide Road*, Southall, the east side, between its junction with Norwood Road and a point opposite the east party wall of Nos. 13 and 15 Adelaide Road.

*Bridge Road*, Southall, between the eastern kerb-line of Merrick Road and a point 50 metres east of that kerb-line.

*Havelock Road*, Southall, between a point 18.29 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Merrick Road and a point 40 metres west of the western kerb-line of Merrick Road.

*Merrick Road*, between a point 60 metres east of the western boundary of No. 2 Merrick Road and its junction with the carriageway comprised in the roundabout situated at or adjacent to the junctions of Merrick Road, Wren Avenue, Norwood Road and Witley Gardens.

*Montague Way*:

(a) the north side, between its junction with Western Road and a point 20 metres west of the western kerb-line of Dagnar Road;

(b) the south side.

*Norwood Road*, between the common boundary of Nos. 110 and 112 Norwood Road and a point 30 metres south-east of a point opposite the south-eastern boundary of Bridge Court, Witley Gardens.

*Western Road*, Southall:

(a) the north-east and north-west side:

(i) between the western kerb-line of King Street, Southall, and a point 15 metres south-west of the western kerb-line of St. John's Road;

(ii) between the common boundary of Nos. 62 and 64 Western Road, Southall, and the common boundary of Nos. 115 and 117 Western Road, Southall;

(b) the south-east and south-west side, between the western kerb-line of King Street, Southall, and the common boundary of Nos. 115 and 117 Western Road, Southall.

*Witley Gardens*, between its junction with the carriageway comprised in the roundabout situated at or adjacent to the junctions of Merrick Road, Wren Avenue, Norwood Road and Witley Gardens, and a point 35 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Norwood Road.

*Wren Avenue*, between its junction with the carriageway comprised in the roundabout situated at or adjacent to the junctions of Merrick Road, Wren Avenue, Norwood Road and Witley Gardens, and a point opposite the western wall of No. 17 Wren Avenue.

The carriageway comprised in the roundabout situated at or adjacent to the junctions of Merrick Road, Wren Avenue, Norwood Road and Witley Gardens.

#### SCHEDULE 2

*Merrick Road*, between its junctions with South Road, Southall, and The Green, Southall, and a point 60 metres east of the western boundary of No. 2 Merrick Road.

#### SCHEDULE 3

*Featherstone Road*, between its junctions with The Green, Southall and King Street, Southall, and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 4 and 6 Featherstone Road.

*King Street*, Southall, between the northern kerb-line of Havelock Road and Western Road, Southall, and its junction with Featherstone Road and The Green, Southall.

*Norwood Road*, between the eastern kerb-line of King Street, Southall, and Adelaide Road, Southall, and the common boundary of Nos. 4 and 6 Norwood Road.

*The Green*, Southall, between the northern kerb-line of Hortus Road and its junction with Featherstone Road and King Street, Southall.

#### SCHEDULE 4

*King Street*, Southall:

(a) the north-west side, between the north-eastern kerb-line of Pluckington Place and a point 36.58 metres south-west of the south-eastern kerb-line of Western Road, Southall;

(b) the south-east side:

(i) between its junction with The Green, Southall, and a point 36.58 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Havelock Road;

(ii) between the north-eastern kerb-line of Norwood Road and a point 21.34 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Havelock Road.
