#### LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1976 ANGLIAN WATER AUTHORITY FELIXSTOWE INTERNAL DRAINAGE DISTRICT.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11(4) and 109(6) of the Land Drainage Act 1976,

proposes to make an order confirming, with modifications, a scheme submitted to him by the Anglian Water Authority under section 11(1) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, making provision for the alteration of boundaries of the Felixstowe Internal Drainage District.

Drainage District. The Scheme affects land lying in the Parishes of Felixstowe and Trimley St. Mary in the District of Suffolk Coastal in the County of Suffolk and may affect the liability to drainage rates of properties in these areas.
