The Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make Orders under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regu-lation Act 1984 on the London-Edinburgh-Thurso Trunk Road (A1) at Berwick Bypass in the District of Berwick-upon-Tweed in the County of Northumberland. The effect of the Orders will be to:

- (i) prohibit any vehicle proceeding in either of the carriageways of the trunk road to enter or proceed through the southernmost gap in the central reserva-tion of that length of the Al known as Berwick Bypass opposite its junction with Castle Terrace (A6105); and
