

- (d) That length of an unnamed lane at the rear of the north-eastern side of Hick Street which extends from a point 5 metres from its junction with Hick Street to a point 12 metres north-west of the said junction.

*The Trunk Road (A487) (Great Darkgate Street, Aberystwyth) (Experimental Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1984.*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 4, 9, 10 and paragraph 27 of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 5th November 1984 will be to prohibit (with certain exceptions) the waiting of any vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day, on the side of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The usual exceptions have also been provided in the Order for vehicles displaying a disabled persons badge.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Ceredigion District Council, Town Hall, Aberystwyth, during a period of 6 weeks from 5th November 1984.

*The Trunk Road (A40) (Bancyfelin Hill, Dyfed) (Prohibition of U-Turns and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 1984*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which shall come into operation on 19th October 1984. The effect of the Order is:

- (a) to prohibit (with certain exceptions) any vehicle proceeding in the eastbound carriageway of those lengths of trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice, to make a U-Turn through any of the gaps in the central reservation so as to proceed in the opposite direction in the westbound carriageway of the trunk road;
- (b) to prohibit (with certain exceptions) any vehicle proceeding in the westbound carriageway of those lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice, to make a U-Turn through any of the gaps in the central reservation, so as to proceed in the opposite direction in the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road;
- (c) to prohibit during such time as shall be indicated by prescribed traffic signs, any vehicle from proceeding through the gap in the central reservation of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan and statement of reasons for making the Order may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of Dyfed County Council, Llanstephan Road, Carmarthen, Dyfed, during a period of 6 weeks from 19th October 1984.

- (b) a point opposite the junction of the trunk road with the B4298;
- (c) a point 6 metres west of the junction of the trunk road with Derllys Road; and
- (d) a point opposite the junction of the trunk road with Penforddilas Road.

**SCHEDULE 2**

The gaps in the central reservation of the London—Fishguard Trunk Road (A40) at Bancyfelin Hill, near Carmarthen in the County of Dyfed which are situated at:

- (a) a point 135 metres east of the centre line of the bridge over Afon Cywyn;
- (b) a point opposite the junction of the trunk road with the unclassified road which connects the trunk road with the B4298 and which lies 200 metres west of that junction of the trunk road with the B4298; and
- (c) a point 55 metres west of its junction with Derllys Road.

**SCHEDULE 3**

The gap in the central reservation of the London—Fishguard Trunk Road (A40) and Bancyfelin Hill, near Carmarthen in the County of Dyfed, which is situated at a point 280 metres east of the junction of the trunk road with Penforddilas Road.
