The Queen has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto Times Newspapers Limited Her Majesty's Royal Licence and Authority that it may bear and use in its corporate capacity on seals or otherwise according to the Laws of Arms certain Armorial Bearings which were granted and assigned to The Times Publishing Company Limited (which Company has from 1967 been known as TPC (Investments) Limited) by Letters Patent under the hands and Seals of Garter, Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster Kings of Arms bearing date the 23rd December 1929: the said Armorial Bearings being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms, otherwise the said Royal Licence and Permission to he void and of none, effort

The Trunk Road (A48) (Western Avenue, Cardiff) (Pre-scribed Routes) Order 1984

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which shall come into operation on 13th December 1984.

The effect of the Order will be:

(1) to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in either an easterly or westerly direction in that length of the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (A48) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road") known as Western Avenue at Cardiff in the County of South Glamorgan to make right-hand turns into Caewal Road; and

(2) to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in either an easterly or westerly direction in that length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this notice
