HARTLEPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Hartlepool Borough Council (Elwick Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1984

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd December 1984, Hartlepool Borough Council (pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Council of the County of Cleveland in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers) made the above-named Order the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than Sunday on the north side of Elwick Road from a point approximately 14 metres east of its junction with Waldon Street in an easterly direction for a further distance of 15 metres approximately.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity and water and for disabled persons.
