HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The A43 Oxford-Market Deeping Trunk Road
(Gosford By-pass Section and Slip Roads) Order 1984*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980 the effect of which is to provide that roads which he proposes to construct along the following routes shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation:—

(i) the length of the new trunk road at Gosford and Water Eaton of about 4.8 kilometres (2.98 miles) between the south side of the Peartree Hill Roundabout and a point on the A43 Trunk Road 365 metres (398 yards) north of its junction with the road to Hampton Poyle; and

(ii) routes for slip roads to connect the main new trunk road with the existing A43 Trunk Road at Peartree Hill.

The M40 London-Oxford-Birmingham Motorway (Waterstock to Warwick Section) and Connecting Roads (No. 1) Scheme 1984

(i) to provide for the exclusive use of traffic of Classes I and II of the classes of traffic set out in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act 1980 a special road about 29.3 miles (47.1 kilometres) in length from a point 490 yards (450 metres) north of the junction between the A43 Trunk Road and the Stoke Lyne Road near Ardley in the county of Oxfordshire and proceeding in a general northerly direction passing to the east of Fritwell, west of Aynho and Kings Sutton, east of Banbury, proceeding then in a general north-westerly direction east of Shotteswell and Warmington, west of Avon Dassett and Burton Dassett, east of Gaydon, north-east of Lighthorne, south-west of Bishops Tachbrook and south of Royal Leamington Spa and Warwick to a point 493 yards (451 metres) north-west of the junction of the A41 and A46 Trunk Roads and the A429 Principal Road south of Warwick, all in the counties of Oxfordshire, Northamptonshire and Warwickshire, and 16 special roads to connect the above-mentioned special road with the A43 Trunk Road near Baynard's Green, south of Banbury in Oxfordshire; the A361 and A422 Principal Roads east of Banbury in Oxfordshire; the B4451 Classified Road at Gaydon, south of Royal Leamington Spa in Warwickshire; the A41 Trunk Road at Oakley Wood, near Bishops Tachbrook, south of Royal Leamington Spa in Warwickshire; the A41 Trunk Road and the B4462 Classified Road north-east of Barford near Warwick in Warwickshire; and the A41 and A46 Trunk Roads and the A429 Principal Road at Longbridge, south of Warwick in Warwickshire; and

(ii) to construct as part of the first mentioned special road three bridges over the navigable waters of the Oxford Canal at Kings Sutton Mill, near Adderbury in Oxfordshire, at Sandhills Farm near Bodicote in Oxfordshire and at Hardwick Farm north of Banbury in Oxfordshire and, in connection therewith, to divert the said canal and towing paths; and

(b) to provide for the said special roads to become trunk roads on the date when the Scheme comes into operation.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

*The County of Hereford and Worcester
(Feckenham Road, Headless Cross, Redditch)
(Restriction of Waiting) Order 1984*

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council propose to make an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers the effect of which will be to restrict the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive on the west side of Feckenham Road in the Borough of Redditch in the County of Hereford and Worcester which extends from its junction with Tennyson Road to its junction with Windmill Drive.

Waiting by vehicles of the under-mentioned classes or for the under-mentioned purposes are exempted from the provisions of the Order:-

- (c) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles;

- (e) for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (f) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the side of length of road and the supply of gas, electricity and water and maintenance of telegraphic lines.

An exemption in the Order also permits the waiting by disabled persons' vehicles displaying a badge issued under the Local Authority's Orange Badge Scheme for a limited period of two hours, return prohibited within a further period of one hour.
