Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the West Wales Division of the Welsh Water Authority by David Roy John, Cross Farm, Freystrop, Haverfordwest, Dyfed, for a combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of stream rising near Middle Hill Chapel and flowing in the direction of Lower Freystrop by means of impounding works at Middle Hill Bridge. LOCAL GOVERNMENT PLANNING AND LAND ACT 1980

The Metropolitan Borough of Oldham (Greenfield, Uppermill, Diggle) Smoke Control Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Oldham Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 intend to make an Order entitled the Metropolitan Borough of Oldham (Greenfield, Uppermill, Diggle) Smoke Control Order 1985 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area and specifying that the Order shall come into operation on 1st April 1986.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order, and by virtue of section 11 (2) of the Clean Air Act 1956, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £200 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity and oil.

Subject to the provisions of section 9 of the Act of 1968 any person who acquires for use in a smoke control area or who sells by retail for delivery in a smoke control area any solid fuel other than an authorised fuel shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £200.

Copies of the proposed Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Legal Department (Room 330), Civic Centre, Oldham, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 28th January 1985.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Director of Legal and Secretarial Services, Civic Centre, West Street, Oldham OL1 1UL, object to the making of the Order.
