## WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1979

*Cotton Waste Reclamation Wages Council (Great Britain)*

The Cotton Waste Reclamation Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of proposals for (1) varying provisions relating to statutory minimum remuneration as set out in the Wages (Cotton Waste Reclamation) Order 1984 (Order CW109), and (2) the revocation of Order CW109.

The Wages Council intends that the revised provisions shall come into operation on 22nd April 1985.

*Notification by BGC of Intention to Construct a New High Pressure Pipeline*

In accordance with section 15 of the Oil and Gas (Enterprise) Act 1982 the Secretary of State for Energy has received notification from the British Gas Corporation stating its intention to construct 10 new high pressure pipelines.

- (i) Approximately 0.13 km in length (Macclesfield to Buxton Diversion) at Hurdfield, Stockport
- (ii) Approximately 0.32 km in length (Stockport to New Mills Diversion) at Warth Meadows, Stockport
- (iii) Approximately 0.34 km in length (Stockport to Denton Diversion) between Dane Bank and Windmill Lane at Tameside
- (iv) Approximately 0.30 km in length at Heol-y-Cyw, Bridgend
- (v) Approximately 0.30 km in length at Bryncethin, Bridgend
- (vi) Approximately 0.60 km in length at Haverford West.
- (vii) Approximately 0.110 km in length at Lampeter, Dyfed
- (viii) Approximately 0.03 km in length at Esgardawe in Carmarthen
- (ix) Approximately 10.9 km between Matching Green and Stansted in Epping Forest, Uttlesford, Essex
- (x) Approximately 0.08 km at Hadleigh in Babergh, Suffolk
