The London Borough of Bromley (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 1) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 26th March 1985 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to amend the London Borough of Bromley (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1970 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order of 1970")

The general effect of the Order is to

(i) amend Schedule 2 of the Order of 1970 in relation to

(a) parking place numbered 12 and named Station Approach Car Park, Hayes so that the charge for parking during any period exceeding 4 hours but not exceeding 24 hours during the permitted period is 40p

(b) parking place numbered 33 and named Station Road Multi-Storey Car Park, Orpington so that in respect of the parking of a motor car (not exceeding 30 cwt unladen weight) the fixed charge is 20p

(ii) amend the charging provisions in respect of the following parking places contained in Schedule 1 of the Order of 1970 as follows
