THANET DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Thanet District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Thanet District Council made an Order on 25th March 1985 under section 35 (1) and (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this notice, which shows the classes of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period for waiting and (where applicable) the scale of charges and the concessions for period ticket holders proposed for each parking place. It will come into operation on 3rd April 1985. The parking places are divided into three different categories in the Schedule, as follows

Part I—Free parking

Part II—Standard charges

Part III—"Short stay"

The Order includes exemptions from any time limits and from the payment of any charges for the following vehicles

(a) invalid carriages,

(b) vehicles issued to disabled persons by the Department of Health and Social Security in lieu of invalid carriages, and

(c) disabled persons' vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge issued under the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982, or a badge having effect under those Regulations as if it were a disabled person's badge

The Order specifies the conditions under which the parking places may be used. Full details are contained in the Order which, together with a map showing the situation of the parking places, may be seen, during normal office hours, at Council Offices, Cecil Street, Margate (Reception or Legal Division)
