Proposed Stopping-up of Highways Associated with the Proposed Wigan Bus Station

Proposed Pedestrianisation of Highways Associated with the Proposed Wigan Bus Station

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Wigan Metropolitan Borough Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on Lever Street and on the lengths of Back Market Street, Queens Hall Passage, Hallgate, and on a part of Crofters Yard at Wigan

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways by vehicles being used

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes,
