ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

The Cardiff-Glan Conwy Trunk Road (Minffordd to Dolwyddelan Improvement) Compulsory Purchase Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above-mentioned Acts, on 10th April 1985, made a Compulsory Purchase Order, entitled as above

The Order as made provides for the purchase of the land and rights described in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of

(i) the construction of a new highway and the provision of new means of access to premises in the Community

of Dolwyddelan in the County of Gwynedd in pursuance of the Cardiff-Glan Conwy Trunk Road (Minffordd-Dolwyddelan Improvement Side Roads) Order 1985,

- (ii) the improvement of the Cardiff-Glan Conwy Trunk Road in the said Community and County,
- (iii) the diversion of watercourses and the execution of other works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new highway, and the improvement of the Trunk Road, and
- (iv) use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and such execution of other works as aforesaid

Copies of the Order as made by the Secretary of State and of the plan referred to therein, together with a copy of the above-mentioned Side Roads Order (together with its accompanying plan) have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours from 19th April 1985 to 31st May 1985 at the offices of Gwynedd County Council, County Offices Caernarfon, Aberconwy Borough Council, Town Hall, Llandudno, Snowdonia National Park Offices, Penrhyndeudraeth, Gwynedd, the Elen's Castle Hotel, Dolwyddelan, Gwynedd, and at the Welsh Office, Roads Administration Division, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff

The Order as made become operative on the date on which this notice is first published but a person aggrieved by the Order may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks from the operative date, question its validity on the grounds

- (i) that the authorisation granted by the Order is not empowered to be granted, or
- (ii) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by failure to comply with any statutory requirement relating to the Order

- (b) References to ownership are references to ownership or reputed ownership at the time of the preparation of the Compulsory Purchase Order and are stated only for the purpose of identification of the land

Land comprised in the Order as made

In the Community of Dolwyddelan

Rough rocky ground part of disused slate quarry tip, rough grassland, pasture land and drainage ditches, rough pasture land and rock outcrop, disused well, ruin of Sunday School and open ditch all on the south-east of the Trunk Road (A470), the right to construct and maintain embankments over rough grassland and exposed rock, the right to lay and maintain a pipe and to construct and maintain a head wall over rough grassland and part of slate tip, the right to remove the old bridge and to construct and maintain a new bridge and to construct and maintain an open lined ditch over pasture land, bank and part bed of Afon Tan-y-Castell all in the ownership of G W Davies and Mrs M Davies (1, 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 3, 3A, 7 and 8)
