 - a minimum temperature of 75°C for a period of at least 15 seconds, or
 - a minimum temperature of 74°C for a period of at least 40 seconds, or
- following preparation of the product every precaution has been taken to prevent contamination of the product
- The final product has been packed in new containers

(c) Destination of the meat, means of transport including registration/flight No
- That the whole of the consignment described in 1 above was derived from poultry which
 - was subject at the slaughterhouse named to ante-mortem inspection by an authorised veterinary officer

and to post-mortem inspection under the supervision of an authorised veterinary officer and no evidence of disease was detected,

- originated from flocks in which, within the preceding two months, none of the following diseases had been diagnosed

Fowl plague, Newcastle disease, Salmonellosis, Fowl Cholera (Pasteurellosis) and Ornithosis, Duck Plague and Duck Virus Hepatitis, Goose Influenza, Baracolon Arizona Infection,

- have not been in contact at the slaughterhouse with any poultry in which any of the diseases mentioned in 2(b) above had been diagnosed,
 - were hatched, reared and slaughtered in a state in which after due enquiry I am satisfied that no outbreak of Velogenic strain of Newcastle disease has been recorded in the last six months
- The poultry carcasses are fully eviscerated and do not contain nor are accompanied by any offal

Each consignment must be accompanied by a certificate signed by a duly authorised Veterinary Officer of the Government of the United States of America certifying

- (a) Details of the consignment, (nature of consignment, e.g., inedible, poultry offal, number of packages, identification marks, etc)
(b) the Registered Number and address of slaughtering and dressing plant
- That the whole of the consignment so described was derived from poultry which
 - was subject at the slaughterhouse named to ante-mortem inspection by an authorised veterinary officer and to post-mortem inspection under the supervision of an authorised veterinary officer and no sign of infectious disease as detected,
 - originated from flocks in which, within the preceding two months, none of the following diseases had been diagnosed

Fowl Plague, Newcastle Disease, Salmonellosis, Fowl Cholera (Pasteurellosis) and Ornithosis

- have not been in contact at the slaughterhouse with any poultry affected by any of the diseases mentioned in (b) above,
 - were hatched, reared and slaughtered in a state in which after due enquiry I am satisfied that no outbreak of a Velogenic strain of Newcastle disease has been recorded in the six months prior to slaughter
- The poultry offal shall be packed in leakproof containers or packages and on arrival shall be transported direct from the point of landing to where it shall be sterilised
