The City Council of Liverpool (Marlsford Street) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1985, to prohibit any vehicle from entering or leaving Marlsford Street at its junction with Sheil Road

The City Council of Liverpool (Passage between Wood-church Road and Wharncliffe Road) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1985, to prohibit any vehicle from entering or leaving the passage adjacent to No 1 Wharncliffe Road, at its junction with Wharncliffe Road other than a cycle not being a motor vehicle

The City Council of Liverpool (St James Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1985, to prohibit, with certain exceptions, any vehicle from waiting at any time on the east side of St James Road from a point 46 metres (150 feet) south of its junction with Upper Duke Street to a point 88 metres (289 feet) south of that junction
