Proposed Stopping up of a Length of and Parts of The Rake, Bromborough

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 1

The A51 Trunk Road (Barony Road, Nantwich) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A51 north of Newcastle-under-Lyme - Nantwich - Tarporley - Tarvin Trunk Road in the Borough of Crewe and Nantwich in the County of Cheshire

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time on any day on the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this notice

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle, to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, to enable the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance of the road or the services therein, to enable a vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets, to enable a disabled person's vehicle to wait for up to 2 hours, or to enable a vehicle to be used for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes.
