 (c) a length of the existing A421 road in Oxfordshire extend-
 - ing for about 0 38 kilometres (0 24 miles) north-eastwards from a point 0 7 kilometres (0 43 miles) north east of its junction with Wendlebury Road at Weston-on-the-Green, and
 - (d) the new highways to which the reference letters B and C are given on the deposited plan to the M40 London-Oxford-Birmingham Motorway (Wendlebury to Gaydon Section Side Roads) (Supplementary) Order 1985 at Wendlebury in Oxfordshire
- An Order under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him

(a) to stop up highways.

(b) to construct new highways

(c) to stop up private means of access to premises, and

(d) to provide new means of access to premises.

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the new trunk road mentioned at 1(a) above and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Oxfordshire as from the date on which he notifies that authority that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic

The M40 London-Oxford-Birmingham Motorway (Wendlebury to Gaydon Side Roads) (Supplementary) Order 1985
