

DARTFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Dartford (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Variation Order 1985 London Road/Woodward Terrace)

Notice is hereby given that the Dartford Borough Council acting as agents for the Kent County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit vehicles waiting in London Road at its junction with Woodward Terrace. The proposed waiting restrictions will extend from the junction in an easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres.

The Order is being made in the interests of road safety.

The Derbyshire County Council (Mark Street, Sandiacre) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that on 27th June 1985 the Derbyshire County Council made an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

When this Order comes into effect on 1st July 1985 you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle on the following lengths of road at Sandiacre:

No Waiting Monday to Saturday 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Mark Street, both sides, from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Station Road throughout its length.

The Derbyshire County Council (Alma Street, Alfreton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that on 27th June 1985 the Derbyshire County Council made an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

When this Order comes into effect on 1st July 1985 you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle on the following lengths of road at Alfreton:

No Waiting Monday to Saturday 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Alma Street,

West side, from a point 26 metres south of its junction with Nottingham Road in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 33 metres.

East side, from a point 26 metres south of its junction with Nottingham Road in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 26 metres.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Martin Street, Plymouth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

- (1) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- (2) To revoke the whole of Schedule 2 of the County of Devon (The Central Area, Plymouth) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1984 as specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.
- (3) To revoke part of Schedule 2 of the County of Devon (Octagon Street Area, Plymouth) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Amendment Order 1975 as specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order permitting waiting for the purposes of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, building and demolition, roadworks and the maintenance of essential services, and for disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the "orange badge" scheme.

Martin Street, east side from its junction with The Octagon southwards to its junction with Bath Place West.

SCHEDULE 2

Martin Street, east side from a point 77 metres north-east of a point opposite the south-west kerb line of Sawrey Street northwards for a distance of 21 metres.

SCHEDULE 3

Martin Street, south-east from its junction with Bath Place West, north-eastwards to a point 77 metres north-east of a point opposite the south-east kerb line of Sawrey Street.

The County of Devon (Masey Road, Exmouth) (One-way Street) Order 1985
