The County of Durham (Borough of Darlington) (Smithfield Road/Neasham Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that on 27th June 1985 Durham County Council made the above-named Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Order (which becomes operative on 1st July 1985) will have the effect set out in the Schedule hereto

There are exemptions in the Order in respect of boarding or alighting, loading or unloading of goods, building operations and demolitions, removal of obstructions to traffic, maintenance of the road, Post Office vehicles, fire brigade, police or ambulance vehicles, statutory powers and disabled persons' vehicles
