HEREFORD & WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Droitwich Road/Ombersley Road, Worcester) (Box Junction) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that on 20th June 1985 Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order under section 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to provide a "yellow box" marking at the junction of Droitwich Road and Ombersley Road in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester

No vehicle shall be driven into the boxed area and therefore driven in such a direction that it becomes necessary, owing to the presence of stationary vehicles, for any part of the vehicle to remain at rest within the boxed area. Unless

- (1) the driver of a vehicle is intending to turn and is prevented from doing so either by oncoming vehicles or by the presence of stationary vehicles provided it is waiting in a convenient position,
- (2) the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden has been obtained,
- (3) the vehicle is in use for police, fire brigade, or ambulance purposes, and
- (4) the vehicle, the driver of which when entering the boxed area had reasonable cause to believe that he would immediately be able to drive the vehicle out of that area

The Order will come into operation on 30th June 1985
