Notice is hereby given that on 20th June 1985, Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order under section 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to prohibit cycling on the entire length of Footpath No 17, Hallow Lane to Crown Mea-dow in the parts of Lower Broadheath in the Distort of dow, in the parish of Lower Broadheath in the District of Malvern Hills in the county of Hereford and Worcester

The Order will come into operation on 29th June 1985

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of Parts I, II or III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, or of any regulations made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made (such date stated in this notice), make application for the purpose to the High Court

- The North Hertfordshire District Council (The Wynd, Letchworth) (Prohibition of Entry and Driving, and Pro-hibition of Watting) Order 1985
- The North Hertfordshire District Council (Station Road and Norton Way South, Openshaw Way, Road rear of Norton Way South, Letchworth) (One-Way Traffic and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the North Hertfordshire District Council, acting as agents for the Hertfordshire County Council, propose to make Orders under sections 1, 2 and 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, in connection with the redevelopment of The Wynd area, Letchworth, the effect of which will be

- (1) To prohibit the entry and driving of motor vehicles in the length of The Wynd, Letchworth, described in the First Schedule except for purposes of gaining access to property only accessible from that length of road, also to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time including a prohibition on loading and unloading in this same length of road. in this same length of road
- (2) To revoke the present Orders relating to The Wynd
- (3) To prohibit motor vehicles and pedal cycles along the length of The Wynd, Letchworth, to be pedestrian-ised as descrabed in the Second Schedule
- (4) To prohibit vehicles from proceeding in the new roads described in the Third Schedule in any direction other than that specified
- (5) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the lengths of Norton Way South and Station Road and the new roads described in the Third Schedule including a prohibition on loading and unloading in the lengths of the new roads described in the Fourth Schedule

The Council also propose, under powers contained in section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to instal road humps at two points in Openshaw Way immediately before this road traverses the pedestrianised section of The Wynd in order to reduce the speed of traffic The construction and dimensions of these humps will be m accordance with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1983 A copy of the draft Orders and other relevant documents may be inspected at my office between 9 a m and 4 30 p m

FIRST SCHEDULE

The Wynd, from its junction with Station Road on both sides southwards for a distance of approximately 45 metres to a point opposite the entrance to the new Shopping Arcade and including the end of this cul-desac

SECOND SCHEDULE

- (1) From its junction with Leys Avenue northwards for a distance of approximately 40 metres to a point adjacent to the northern boundary of No 38 Leys Avenue,
- (11) From a point approximately 47 metres from its junction with Leys Avenue northwards for a distance of approximately 62 metres

THIRD SCHEDULE

- Openshaw Road, (linking Station Road, The Wynd and Norton Way South, Letchworth), from Station Road to Norton Way South Letchworth
- The road along the rear of the properties on the western side of the section of Norton Way South between the junctions with Openshaw Way, from north to south
- Norton Way South, on the west side, from a point approx-imately 23 metres south of the southern boundary of No 121 Norton Way South for a distance of approxi-mately 90 metres to a point approximately 10 metres north of the southern boundary of No 115 Norton Way South
- Station Road, on the south side, from a point opposite the western boundary of No 50C Station Road westwards for a distance of approximately 50 metres to a point opposite the boundary between Nos 65 and 67 Station Road
