London Borough of Lambeth Council's Proposed Increase in Charges at Metered Parking Places in Zone No 1

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") are applying to the Greater London Council under sections 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, for an Order to be entitled the Lambeth (Parking Places) (Amendment No ) Order 198

The general effect of the Order would be

At all the on-street metered parking places in Zone 1 in the London borough of Lambeth, to increase the rate of the initial charge and to alter the initial periods for the leaving of vehicles to 20 pence for 20 minutes (maximum period—2 hours) at 2-hour parking places and to 20 pence for 20 minutes (maximum period 4 hours) at 4-hour parking places

The streets in the controlled parking zone containing designated metered parking places will be affected in one or more ways by the proposals referred to above. The classes of vehicles for which the parking places would be available and the permitted hours for parking

would remain unchanged

A copy of the proposed Order of the Lambeth (Parking Places) Order 1970 (and of the Orders which have amended or applied to that Order) and of the Council's statement or applied to that Order) and of the Council's statement of reasons for applying for the proposed Order can be inspected during a period of 21 days from 28th June 1985 between the hours of 9 30 a m and 4 30 pm on Monday to Fridays at the Town Hall, Brixton Hill, London S W 2, or the Parking Control Office, George West House, Clapham Common North Side, London S W 4. Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing specifying the grounds for the objection to the Director of Planning and Transportation, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB, quoting PT/TD/PO/R, within the above mentioned period of 21 days
