The Trunk Road (A487) (Dyfi Bridge, Machynlleth) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Experimental) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will come into operation on 22nd July 1985

The effect of the Order is to prohibit (with certain exceptions) the waiting of any vehicle at any time in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice

A copy of the Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be inspected during normal office hours in the reception area of the Area Offices of Montgomery District Council, The Plas, Machynlleth, during 6 weeks from 21st June 1985

Copies of the Order may be obtained free of charge, on application to the Welsh Office, Transport, Highways and Planning Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanushen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, quoting ref WR 15/6/213

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instruments made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within the aforesaid period of 6 weeks apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein

SCHEDULE

That length of the Fishguard-Bangor Trunk Road (A487) at Dyfi Bridge, Machynlleth in the Counties of Powys and Gwynedd which extends from the southern end of the Dyfi Bridge in a general southerly direction for a distance of 152 metres (2 SI)
