TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Derby City Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on parts of Poole Street and Allen Street at Allenton, Derby

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways

(1) by vehicles being used

(a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes,

(b) on behalf of a statutory undertaker or British Telecommunications and engaged upon the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878, under, in, on, over, along or across the highways or any land adjacent to the highways,

(c) on behalf of a water authority and engaged upon the laying, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any public sewer under, in, on, over, along or across the highways or any land adjacent to the highways, and

(2) by pedal cycles
