THE TRUNK ROAD (A494) (LLANFERRES, CLWYD) (DE-RESTRICTION) ORDER 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 82 and 83 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will come into operation on 29th July 1985 The effect of the Order will be to de-restrict the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice

TELFORD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY OVER VARIOUS FOOTPATHS AT THE ROCK, TELFORD

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the Public Rights of Way over the following routes shown by a red line on the map hereinafter referred to

- 1 That part of the road used as a public path No 183 from a point marked "A" on the map at its junction with the Rock and running for a distance of approximately 75 metres in a north-easterly direction to a point marked "B" on the map,
- 2 That length of footpath No 184 from a point marked "B" on the map at its junction with the road used as a public path No 183 and running for a distance of approximately 213 metres in a north-easterly direction to its junction with footpath No 186 at a point "C" on the map,
- 3 That length of footpath No 186 from a point marked "C" on the map at its junction with footpath No 184 and running for a distance of approximately 170 metres in a north-easterly direction, through a point marked "D" on the map, to a point marked "E" on the map,
- 4 That length of footpath No 185 from a point marked "C" on the map at its junction with footpaths Nos 184 and 186 and running for a distance of approximately 130 metres in a north-westerly direction through a point marked "F" on the map to a point marked "G" on the map,
