#### UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

Statutes made by the Governing Bodies of

- (1) St Edmund Hall, in the University of Oxford on 21st June 1985, amending Statutes V and XIII,
- (2) The Queen's College, in the University of Oxford on 1st July 1985, amending Statutes V, VI, VIII, IX and X,

have been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of their having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

The purpose of (1) above is to establish a system of regular re-election for Fellows, and alter the procedure for amending the Statutes of the College.

The purpose of (2) above is to amend the conditions of election to and tenure of various scholarships. (1 SI)

THE QUEEN has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto The Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy Her Majesty's Royal Licence and Authority that it may bear and use on its Common Seal or otherwise according to the Laws of Arms certain Armorial Ensigns and Supporters which were granted and assigned to the Institute of Municipal Treasurers and Accountants (Incorporated) by Letters Patent under the hands and Seals

of Garter, Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster Kings of Arms bearing date the 20th June 1955, the said Armorial Ensigns and Supporters being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms, otherwise the said Royal Licence and Permission to be void and of none effect.

And to command that the said Royal Concession and Declaration be recorded in the said College of Arms. (2 SI)
