ROYAL LICENCE

POLICE AUTHORITY FOR NORTHERN IRELAND

By Royal Warrant bearing date the sixth day of June
1985 Her Majesty The Queen has given and granted unto
the Police Authority for Northern Ireland Her Majesty's
Royal Licence and Authority that as a body corporate
the said Police Authority for Northern Ireland might bear
and use Armorial Ensigns as are hereinafter described
and blazoned videlicet Argent a cross Gules in the dexter
chief a dexter hand couped at the wrist also Gules overall
supported by a Lion and an Irish Elk both rampant and
each collared all Or an escutcheon Vert charged with a
Harp Or stringed of ten Argent ensigned by a Royal
Crown Proper the said Armorial Ensigns to be granted
and assigned by Her Majesty's Kings of Arms and
pursuant to Her Majesty's said Royal Licence and Authority
to be duly exemplified and recorded in Her Majesty's
College of Arms otherwise Her Majesty's said Royal
Licence and permission to be void and of none effect,
Her Majesty The Queen having required and commanded
further that Her Majesty's said Concession and Especial
Mark of Her Majesty's Royal Favour also be recorded in
Her Majesty's College of Arms
