#### A PROCLAMATION

Appointing Wednesday, 1st January 1986 and Monday, 5th May 1986 as Bank Holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and Thursday, 26th December 1985 and Monday, 26th May 1986 as Bank Holidays in Scotland

Whereas We consider it desirable that Wednesday, the first day of January and Monday, the fifth day of May in the year 1986 should be bank holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and that Thursday, the twenty-sixth day of December in the year 1985 and Monday, the twentysixth day of May in the year 1986 should be bank holidays ur Scotland

We, therefore, in pursuance of section 1 (3) of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971, do hereby appoint Wednesday, the first day of January and Monday, the fifth day of May in the year 1986 to be bank holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and Thursday the twenty-sixth day of December in the year 1985 and Monday, the twenty-sixth day of May in the year 1986 to be bank holidays in Scotland.
