

**RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS BY THE PUBLIC  
WORKS LOAN COMMISSIONERS TO LOCAL  
AUTHORITIES**

**NOTICE**

TREASURY MINUTE dated 14th August 1985

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury read section 3(2) of the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 c 13 as amended) whereby any sums borrowed from the Public Works Loan Commissioners shall bear interest at such rates as the Treasury may determine from time to time in accordance with section 5 of the said Act

My Lords understand that the Public Works Loan Commissioners will be operating arrangements under which local authorities are permitted to borrow from the Commissioners up to a specified quota at a certain fixed rate of interest and in excess of such quota at one of two higher fixed rates

In accordance therewith the Chancellor of the Exchequer now recommends that with effect from 14th August 1985 and until the coming into operation of a further determination

- I The rate of interest applicable to any such fixed rate loan will be that in force on the day the authority applies to borrow or if the application is before noon three working days before the loan is credited to the account of the authority's banker the rate in force at 11 a.m. two banking days before credit day
- II Different rates of interest shall be charged on such fixed rate loans according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and if repaid by instalments whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E I P) or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E R)
- III The rates of such interest shall be

PWL B Non quota B Rate loans will bear interest at 1 per cent above the corresponding Non-quota A rates

The amount which a local authority borrows within its annual quota will bear interest at the appropriate rate in the quota set of rates. Authorities may borrow further sums at quota rates at the discretion of the Public Works Loan Commissioners. Other borrowing beyond the quota entitlement will be at the appropriate rate in the non quota set of rates

**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE**

**NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS AND  
EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT 1979**

To Lieutenant Commander Robert B Jordan Pursuant to section 139 (6) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979 and paragraph 1 of the 3rd Schedule thereto the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give you notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts and any enactments amending those Acts certain goods namely

One Daihatsu Motor Caravan Registration No FYY 510W

has been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that

1 The said goods being goods chargeable with a duty of customs and excise were relieved from that duty on the condition that they would be exported by you on your departure from the United Kingdom and that condition was not complied with in that the said goods were not exported by you on your departure from the United Kingdom on or about 1st December 1983

2 The said goods being goods chargeable with a duty of customs and excise were relieved from that duty on condition that they would not be offered for sale and that condition was not complied with in that the goods were offered for sale on or about May 1984

Whereby and by force of section 124 (1) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979 the said goods are liable to forfeiture

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance with the said Schedule to the said Act. In default of such notice the said goods will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited and will be liable to be disposed of in such manner as the Commissioners of Customs and Excise may direct. If you make such claim within the time afore said legal proceedings will be taken for the condemnation thereof
