NEWCASTLE-UPON-TYNE CITY COUNCIL

The City of Newcastle-upon-Tyne (Titan Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd October 1985 the City Council of Newcastle-upon-Tyne, as agents for the Tyne and Wear County Council, made the above-named Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Order will come into effect on 7th October 1985 and will prohibit waiting at any time along the north side of Titan Road from its junction with Lamb Street for 65 metres in a north-easterly direction

Exemptions in the Order permit waiting for certain purposes, including

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers,
- (b) loading and unloading goods, and
- (c) disabled persons

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Central Core, Nottingham) (No 1) (Experimental Amendment) Extension Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be that the Nottinghamshire County Council (Central Core, Nottingham) (No 1) Experimental Amendment Order 1984 will continue in full force from 20th October 1985 until 19th April 1986 inclusive. The Order provides that vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding in the following roads in the City of Nottingham between 11 a m and 4 30 p m on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive

- (1) *Albert Street*

Exemptions will be provided for police vehicles, emergency vehicles, statutory undertakers vehicles, shop fitters/builders by prior arrangement. Certain other vehicles will be permitted

NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Glasshouse Street and Howard Street, Nottingham) (Experimental Traffic Regulation) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be

- (1) Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting, loading and unloading between 8 a m and 6 p m on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, in the following length of road in the City of Nottingham

Glasshouse Street, its west side, from a point 60 metres north of its junction with Lower Parliament Street to a point 20 metres south of the centre line of its junction with *St Ann's Street*,

- (2) There will be a one-way traffic restriction on *Howard Street*, in the City of Nottingham, allowing vehicles to move only in the direction from south-west to north-east (i.e. from *Glasshouse Street* towards *Huntingdon Street*) the opposite direction from that which presently operates

Relevant documents may be inspected at my office or at the office of the Secretary and Solicitor, Nottingham City Council, The Guildhall, Nottingham. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, not later than 31st October 1985, apply to the High Court for this purpose

The Order will come into operation on 6th October 1985 and will (unless extended) continue in force until 2nd March 1986 inclusive
