GOSPORT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Gosport (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Gosport Borough Council (as Agents for the Hampshire County Council) on the 4th November 1985 made an Order under sections 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which will revoke and replace the existing Off-Street Parking Places Order 1972.

The new Order will come into effect on the 11th November 1985 and will regulate the use of the parking places for vehicles as specified in the Schedule to this notice. The Order includes provision for:—

- (a) The conduct of persons in the parking places;
- (b) the prohibition of carrying out repairs, breaking up or stripping, maintenance or washing of vehicles;
- (c) The prohibition of the use of any tent, caravan, shelter or structure for human habitation or camping;
- (d) The parking of vehicles conveying inflammable, noxious or dangerous substances to be restricted to parking place No. 1;
- (e) The exclusion of public service vehicles (except in parking place No. 28) and goods vehicles (except in parking place No. 1) exceeding 1525 kilograms unladen weight, vehicles in a dangerous derelict condition;
- (f) The prohibition of vehicles not displaying current road tax or current insurance in relation to the driver of the vehicle;
- (g) A 48 hour time limit and the manner of parking;
- (h) The removal of vehicles from the parking places in certain circumstances;
- (i) The exclusion of trailers, caravans, boats, stores, luggage, matter or thing in a manner likely to impede or obstruct entry or exit facilities.

The Order together with a plan showing the location of the parking places concerned may be examined in my Department at the Town Hall, Gosport during normal office hours (except Saturdays).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act, or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of making the Order, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

16. The parking place situated off the south side of White Hart Road.
17. The parking place situated off the south side of South Street at the junction with Stone Lane.
18. The parking place situated off the south side of South Street at the junction with Alver Road.
19. The parking place situated off the south side of South Street at the junction with Molesworth Road.
20. The parking place situated off the south side of South Street at the junction with Kensington Road.
21. The parking place situated off the south side of South Street adjoining Shaftesbury Road.

The Leicester (Street Parking Places) (Motor cycles) (Amendment) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that Leicester City Council as Agents authorised by Leicestershire County Council have made the following Order under Sections 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to come into operation on 11th November 1985.

The effect of this Order will be to:

Introduce a parking place for motor cycles only to have unrestricted waiting on the south-east side of *Millstone Lane* between a point 20 metres south-west of its junction with Market Street and a point 13 metres north-east of its junction with *Pocklington's Walk*.

LEICESTER CITY COUNCIL

The Leicester Traffic Regulation (Victoria Road East) (Amendment) (No. 274) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that Leicester City Council as Agents authorised by Leicestershire County Council have made the following Order under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to come into operation on 2nd December 1985.

The effect of this Order will be to:

Prohibit vehicles waiting at any time, except for permitted loading for a period of 20 minutes between the hours of 9.30 a.m. to 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 7.30 a.m. Monday to Friday and all day Saturday and Sunday in:

Victoria Road East, the north-west side between points 63 metres and 123 metres south of its junction with *Braybrooke Road*.
