The Secretary of State gives notice pursuant to section 1 (4) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949 to those licensed under either a Ship Licence or a Ship Licence (VHF), which have been issued and remain in force, of the following variation to both the above-named licences:

As from 1st January 1986 the use of International marine frequency Channel 70 (156.525 MHz) is amended under the International Radio Regulations of the International Telecommunication Union. From the aforementioned date, Channel 70 is assigned exclusively for distress and safety purposes using digital selective calling (DSC), and must not be used for any other purpose whatsoever. The First Schedfor any other purpose whatsoever. The First Schedule to the licence is to be amended accordingly.

Current holders of the Ship Licence and Ship Licence (VHF) will be issued with a Notice of Variation to their licence as and when it comes up for renewal. There are no immediate plans to issue new schedules to current licensees.
