The Trunk Road (A48) (Caerwent and Penhow, Gwent) (Prohibition of Right-hand Turns) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which will come into operation on 16th February 1986.

The effect of the Order is that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding:

- (a) in an easterly direction in that length of the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (A48) at Caerwent in the County of Gwent to make a right hand turn into the

unclassified road leading to Burton Villas, Caerwent, and

- (b) in a westerly direction in that length of the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (A48) at Rock Farm, Penhow in the County of Gwent to make a right hand turn into the unclassified road leading to Llanvaches.

Provision for emergency vehicles has been made in the Order which also revokes the temporary Order made on 13th May 1985.

A copy of the Order, a copy of the Order being revoked, together with a plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Monmouth District Council, Chepstow Area Office, High Trees, Chepstow, Gwent during a period of 6 weeks from 10th January 1986.

Copies of the Order may be obtained free of charge, on application to the Welsh Office, Transport, Highways and Planning Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff, quoting ref. WR15/3/272.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any Instruments made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within the aforesaid period of 6 weeks apply to the Highways Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
