#### WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

##### *The Annesley Woodhouse Quarry (Nottinghamshire) Nature Conservation Revocation Order 1985*

Notice is hereby given under paragraph 6 (2) (b) of Schedule 11 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act that the Secretary of State has considered the above Order and has decided to confirm it.

The general effect of the Revocation Order is to revoke the Annesley Woodhouse Quarry (Nottinghamshire) Nature Conservation Order 1983 ("The 1983 Order").

#### WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 29

##### *The Annesley Woodhouse Quarry (Nottinghamshire) Nature Conservation Revocation Order 1985*

Whereas:

- (1) The Secretary of State made the Annesley Woodhouse Quarry Nature Conservation Order 1983 ("the 1983 Order") which took effect when it was made on 24th June 1983;
- (2) The Nature Conservancy Council has since the 1983 Order purchased the land described in that Order;
- (3) The Secretary of State has consulted the Nature Conservancy Council, and
- (4) The Secretary of State has decided to make an Order revoking the 1983 Order.

Now therefore the Secretary of State in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 29 (1) and paragraph 1 of Schedule 11 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders that the 1983 Order shall be revoked.

This Order may be cited as the Annesley Woodhouse Quarry (Nottinghamshire) Nature Conservation Revocation Order 1985.

## DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Tamworth Borough Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right

which persons may have to use vehicles on lengths of Saxon Mill Lane (formerly Mill Lane) and The Knob at Tamworth in the County of Staffordshire.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
