### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

*Pedestrianisation of Lengths of Albert Road and Charnock Street, Preston*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Preston Borough Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of Albert Road and a length of Charnock Street, Preston, Lancashire.

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

*Stopping-up of Highways Associated with the Bus/Rail Interchange, Bolton*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of Essex, Goodman and Suggitt; on behalf of the British Railways Board and the Greater Manchester Passenger Transport Executive; he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping Up of Highways (County of Greater Manchester) (No. 6) Order 1986" authorising the stopping-up of a length of Station Street; a part width of Trinity Street fronting Bolton Station; and a subway passing under Trinity Street with associated ramps and steps.
