## HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The (A629) North-West of Doncaster-Kendal Trunk Road (Dolesway Junction Side Roads) Order 1986*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at its junction with the Keighley Road (A6068), Cross Hills, in the County of North Yorkshire, he has made under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 an Order, the effect of which is:

- (a) to authorise him:
  - (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
  - (ii) to stop up highways;
  - (iii) to stop up private means of access to premises; and
