### WELSH OFFICE

*The Trunk Roads. (A465/A40/A449/A4042) (Clearways) Order 1986*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will come into operation on 11th April 1986.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit (with certain exceptions) vehicles stopping along the carriageways of that

length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this notice; trading from the verges will also be prohibited.

The Order also revokes the provisions of the Trunk Roads (A465/A40/A449/A4042) (Clearways) Order 1984.

A copy of the Order, a copy of the Order being revoked, together with a plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Blaenau Gwent District Council, Council Offices, Alma Street, Brynmawr, Gwent, during a period of 6 weeks from 10th March 1986.

Copies of the Order may be obtained free of charge, on application to the Welsh Office, Directorate of Highways, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff, quoting ref. WR 15/3/256.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any Instruments made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within the aforesaid period of 6 weeks apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

### SCHEDULE

That length of the Newport-Worcester Trunk Road (A449/A40) in the County of Gwent which extends from a point 55 metres south-west of the centre of the Dixon Roundabout at Monmouth in a general north-easterly direction to the boundary between the County Councils of Gwent and Hereford-Worcester, a distance of approximately 2,150 metres.

#### NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Anglian Water Authority, Colchester Division by T. D. Ridley & Sons (Brewery) Limited of Hartford End, near Chelmsford, Essex, to vary the licence (serial number 8/37/35/72) to abstract water from a well sunk in the gravel at
