DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Langs Road, Paignton) (Parking Place) (Experimental) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that Devon County Council propose to make an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

When the proposed experimental Order comes into effect, both sides of the whole of the length of Langs Road, Paignton, will be reserved as a parking place for permit holders only, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily.

There will be exemptions in the Order for emergency services, postal deliveries, loading and unloading and for any vehicles waiting for a period of less than 2 hours in the restricted period. There is also an exemption for disabled persons' vehicles displaying an "orange badge".

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Alphington Street and Adjacent Roads, Exeter) (Prohibition of Waiting and Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) Order 1986.

Notice is hereby given that Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part 4 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

When the proposed Order comes into effect you will not be able to leave your vehicle at any time in:

Isca Road, both sides, from its junction with Haven Road southwards for a distance of 10 metres.

Haven Road, south side, from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Isca Road to its junction with Water Lane.

Water Lane

North-east side, from a point 80 metres south-east of its junction with Haven Road south-eastwards for a distance of 63 metres.

North-east side, from a point 163 metres south-east of its junction with Haven Road south-eastwards for a distance of 20 metres.

North-east side, from a point 281 metres south-east of its junction with Haven Road south-eastwards for a distance of 20 metres.

North-east side, from a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Tan Lane north-westwards for a distance of 25 metres.

South-west side, from its junction with Haven Road south-eastwards for a distance of 248 metres.

South-west side, from a point 281 metres south-east of its junction with Haven Road to its junction with Willeys Avenue.

Willeys Avenue

South side, from its junction with Tan Lane westwards for a distance of 23 metres.

North side, from its junction with Water Lane westwards for a distance of 20 metres.

Exemptions in the Order permit waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading, boarding and alighting, Post Office services, maintenance of the road, supply of gas, water and electricity, pursuance of statutory powers or duties, taking in petrol, oil or air from a garage. The statutory exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles are included.

HASTINGS BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Hastings Borough Council (Disabled Drivers Parking Places) (Order 1981) Amendment Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Hastings Borough Council, as agents for the East Sussex County Council, the Highway Authority, in exercise of the powers under sections 32, 35 and 36 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, propose to amend the Schedule to the Hastings Borough Council (Disabled Drivers Parking Places) Order 1981.

HUMBERSIDE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Humberside (Glanford Borough) (High Street, Mill Lane and Town Hill, Broughton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1986.

Notice is hereby given that on 25th March 1986 the Humberside County Council made this Order which will be operative from 1st May 1986 and the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time in parts of the following roads in Broughton:

(a) *High Street*, both sides, from the western kerb-line of Mill Lane in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 92 metres.

(b) *Mill Lane*, west side, from the southern kerb-line of High Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 35 metres.

(c) *Town Hill*, west side, from the northern kerb-line of High Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 50 metres.

Exemptions to the Order will include permission to wait for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading, the maintenance of roads, gas, water and electricity supplies and for fire, police and ambulance purposes.

A copy of the Order and relevant map may be examined during normal office hours at the Administration Department, County Hall, Beverley (ref. BAS/23067), and the Post Office, Broughton.

If you wish to question the validity of this Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 25th March 1986, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
