#### TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Securities Office, Bank of England, Threadneedle Street on Friday 11th April 1986 at 1 p.m., for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877, and the

National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of  $\pounds 100,000,000$ . 2. The Bills will be in amounts of  $\pounds 5,000$ ,  $\pounds 10,000$ ,  $\pounds 25,000$ ,  $\pounds 50,000$ ,  $\pounds 100,000$   $\pounds 250,000$  or  $\pounds 1,000,000$ . They will be dated at the option of the tenderer on any business day from Monday 14th April 1986 to Friday 18th April 1986 inclusive and will be due 91 days after date. 3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of

England.

4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than 50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills re-quired are to be dated and the net amount per cent. (being a multiple of half of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.
