ALKALI ETC. WORKS REGULATION ACT 1906 APPOINTMENT OF INSPECTORS

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 10 of the Alkali Etc. Works Regulation Act 1906, as adapted by Article 3(4) of the Government of Ireland (Adaptation of Enactments) (No. 2) Order 1922 and now vested in it, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby appoints: John Caulfield

- (b) ascertain the quantity of gas discharged into the atmosphere, condensed or otherwise dealt with by applying any such tests as seem to them to be necessary or proper for that purpose.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AN INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IMPOUNDING WORKS

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Wessex Water Authority, Avon & Dorset Division, by Mr. & Mrs. C. M. Campbell for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of a tributary of the River Stour by means of lakes with dams at part O.S. 5775 and part O.S. 5161, Whistley, Milton-on-Stour, Gillingham, Dorset.

The object of impounding water by means of the works is to form lakes.

The capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be approximately 620,000 gallons.

A copy of the application and of any map, plan or other

document submitted with it may be inspected free of charge at Wessex House, High Street, Gillingham, Dorset at all reasonable hours during the period beginning on 16th April 1986 and ending on 14th may 1986.

Any person who wishes to make representations about the application should do so in writing to the Divisional Director of the Wessex Water Authority, Avon & Dorset Division at 2 Nuffield Road, Poole, Dorset before the end of the said period.
