Park Road, on the south side, from its junction with Richard Street (west side) to a point approximately 16 metres west of its junction with Campion Street (west side).

Back Park Road (south):

(1) On the north side from its junction with Richard Street (west side) to its junction with Bentley Street (east side); then from its junction with Bentley Street (west side) to its junction with Benson Street (east side); then from its junction with Benson Street (west side) in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 12 metres; then in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres; then in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 3 metres; then in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres; then in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 13 metres up to its junction with Campion Street (east side).
