SUNDERLAND BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Sunderland (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Sunderland in exercise of its powers under section 35 (1) and (3), and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers propose to make an Order the effect of which will be to revoke the Borough of Sunderland (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1983 and to control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this notice, which Schedule shows the classes of vehicles the days and times of operation, the maximum period of waiting, the scale of charges proposed for each parking place.
